We shall save rubber, money, spiders, paper, and lots of other things to help Uncle Sam.

We heard that Don's sister, 2 years old Ellen Jean was lost this morning.

We have a new pupil in our class whose name is David Crowton. We are going to mate him feel at home.

This morning school started at $9: 00$ o'clock A.M. because the days are longer.
